Notice Inviting Project Proposals under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) in the state of Chhattisgarh

National Rural Livelihood Mission, MoRD, GOI is implementing placement linked skill development program named Deen Dayal Upadhyaya -Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU GKY). Chhattisgarh State Rural Livelihood Mission (CGSRLM-Bihaan) is the Nodal Agency to implement the program in the State.

2. In view of simplification & streamlining of project application process, as per the notification 20/2017 dated 3rd April 2017 of MoRD GOI, CGSRLM (Bihaan) invites proposal from registered Project Implementation Agency (PIA with valid PRN No.) with MoRD, Govt. of India for the implementation of **DDU GKY & Roshni project** in the state. Interested agencies may submit their proposals online at <http://www.ruralskills.in/> along with application fee of Rs. 25,000 to be paid to the following bank account number.

3. The application for **Roshni Project** should also be done on <http://www.ruralskills.in/>. Interested PIAs has to select Roshni from the drop-down menu while applying for the projects in Roshni districts.

4. Project appraisal fee would be payable separately to those projects which are recommended for qualitative appraisal in initial screening stage. The fee would be notified separately.

5. Submission of proposals is a continuous process & the cutoff date for this round of application would be **31st July 2017**. The proposals submitted on or before **31st July 2017**, would be considered in this round & application received after aforesaid date shall be considered in next round of application subject to the availability of. targets with the state. Incomplete proposal in any respect shall be summarily rejected.

6. As per the targets available with the state at present, the PIAs should submit the proposal for long term duration courses only (greater than or equal to 1152 hours). Proposals submitted only for short term duration courses will not be considered in this round of appraisal.



7. PIAs are encouraged to apply for project in sectors like **Manufacturing (Mineral/Metal based), Mining & Quarrying, Steel & Iron, Power, Food Processing/Agriculture, Apparel Transportation and logistics, Healthcare, Hospitality & Handicraft.** Least preference will be given to the projects in sectors like **Retail, IT & ITeS and Telecom.**

8. The priority order of the application will be decided on the basis of MoRD Notification no 20/2017 dated 03rd April 2017, however, PIAs who have applied as a 'captive employer' or can provide 'captive placement' (as defined in the DDU-GKY guideline) would be given preference across the PIA categories. Preference will also be given to the PIAs who have experience in training & placement of 'Divyang'(PwD) & wish to apply exclusively for 'Divyang Candidates'.

9. The application process is a completely online process hence there is no need to send the hard copy of documents. The entire process of application of proposals, screening & selection will be done strictly as per the guidelines & norms laid out by MoRD for the purpose. Allotment of the districts may be done by CGSRLM based on the requirement/demand. While formulating the proposal revised CNN (Cost Norms Notification) may be taken into account as per MoRD notifications No. 25, dated 4th May 2016.
